## Presentation and report regarding monthly operations of the Oklahoma Statewide Virtual Charter School Board (SVCSB)

Dr. Rebecca Wilkinson, Executive Director, SVCSB, presented the monthly operations report of the SVCSB that included a meeting update with Oklahoma Office of Educational Quality and Accountability (OEQA), Epic performance review and QEQA data review; and Oklahoma Virtual Charter Academy parent letter.

Dr. Wilkinson reported how virtual education benefited a high school student enrolled in a large suburban school. The principal contact the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board office and relayed the student was offered a contract opportunity to model in Europe during the fall semester. It was decided the student would model one semester in the fall while continuing education virtually then return the spring semester to complete high school graduation requirements.

### Renewal of Authorization and Sponsorship of Oklahoma Virtual Charter Academy (OVCA) Approved

Dr. Wilkinson presented an application renewal recommendation for Oklahoma Virtual Charter Academy (OVCA) to extend the current five-year contract expiring June 30, 2016, for two (2) years through June 30, 2018. Organizational problems and fiscal mistakes were corrected; organization procedures were resolved and heightened; and the application met all components of the application criteria in accordance with the SVCSB expectations.

Board members asked questions and discussed application renewal and contract terms.

Debbie Long moved to approve the Oklahoma Virtual Charter Academy (OVCA) renewal of authorization and sponsorship for two (2) years, expiring June 30, 2018. Pamela Vreeland seconded the motion. The motion carried with the following votes: Mr. Harrington, yes; Ms. Long, yes; Ms. Vreeland, yes; and Ms. Floyd, yes.

### Public relations and communication services required by the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board (SVCSB)

Dr. Wilkinson said inquiries have been made on how fulltime virtual education can be communicated, what it is and what it looks like for public relations, community outreach and statewide outreach.

Board members asked questions and discussed lists of communication needs, requirements and vendor qualifications.
