June 9, 2015 Statewide Virtual Charter School Board Regular Meeting Minutes Approved

OPENING COMMENTS

A recognition plaque was presented to Jaared Scott for his service on the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board representing Congressional District 3.

ADMINISTRATION

Presentation and report regarding monthly operations of the Oklahoma Statewide Virtual Charter School Board (SVCSB)

Dr. Rebecca Wilkinson, Executive Director, SVCSB, presented the monthly operations report of the SVCSB that included National Charter School Conference summary of comments; Oklahoma State School Board Association (OSSBA) trainings; August student enrollments; public relations/communications draft proposal; and Senate Bill 136 course requirements.

Matthew Hamrick has been nominated to serve on the SVCSB representing Congressional District 3 and will appear after November 1, 2015.

Dr. Wilkinson reported virtual charter schooling benefited a family seeking advice regarding their concerns with an abuse/violent child, and the need for intensive psychological assistance. The choosing a virtual charter school was a right fit for continuing the child's education instead of the confines of a brick and mortar school.

Proposed School Evaluation Services through the Oklahoma Office of Educational Quality and Accountability (OEQA) Approved

Dr. Sherry Labyer and Dr. Kathryn Stehno, OEQA presented a proposal for performance evaluation services of virtual charter schools. The purpose, goals, and accomplishing accountability, framework, peer review, timelines and costs were reviewed.

Board members asked questions and discussed evaluation experience, services and assistance.

Pamela Vreeland moved to approve the proposed School Evaluation Services as written and move to the contract phase. Denise Floyd seconded the motion. The motion carried with the following votes: Mr. Harrington, yes; Ms. Vreeland, yes; and Ms. Floyd, yes.

Memorandum of Understanding between the Oklahoma Statewide Virtual School Board (SVCSB) and the Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE) Approved

Steven Barker, Assistant General Counsel, Office of the Attorney General reviewed the changes and differences to the new State Department of Education and SVCSB 2015 MOU contract.

Board members asked questions and discussed the State Superintendent contract changes and cost percentages.

Denise Floyd moved to approve the amended MOU contract between SVCSB and OSDE. Pamela Vreeland seconded the motion. The motion carried with the following votes: Mr. Harrington, yes; Ms. Vreeland, yes; and Ms. Floyd, yes.

Presentation of the Application for Renewal of Authorization by the Oklahoma Virtual Charter Academy (OVCA)

Sheryl Tatum, Head of School, Oklahoma Virtual Charter Academy (OVCA) and staff members presented a virtual charter school renewal application with supporting evidence, improvement plans, and future charter plans per the renewal guidance.

Board members asked questions and discussed student skills assessments, school improvements and partnerships.
